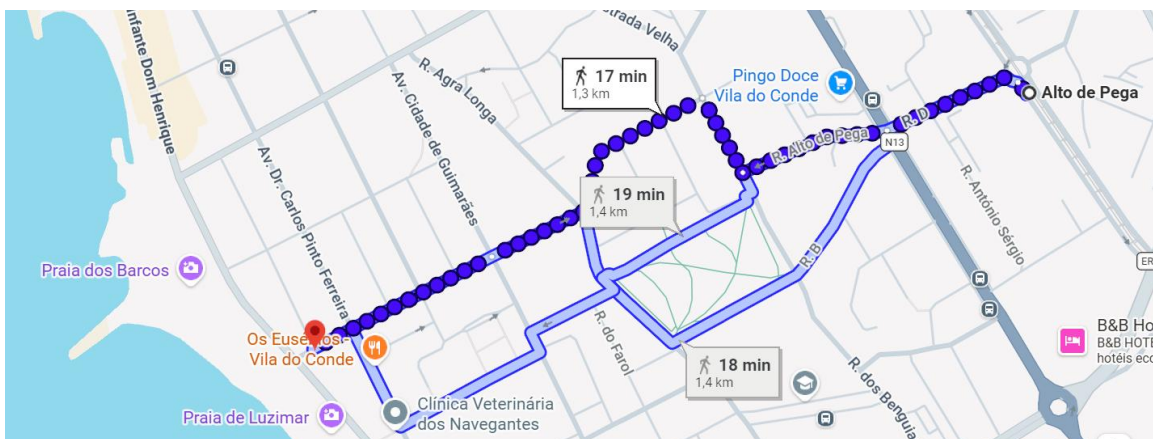

## Corno de Bico Protected Landscape



The Corno de Bico Protected Landscape covers just over 2,000 hectares of rounded mountain terrain, marked by distinctive granite block formations and a mosaic of oak forests, riparian woods, pine stands, “lameiros” (seminatural wet meadows), and a rare peat-forming bog. The area hosts 439 plant species, including endemics such as *Bruchia vogesiaca* and *Veronica micrantha*, and supports diverse wildlife, from numerous bird species to mammals like the Iberian wolf.

Human presence in the region is ancient, evidenced by megalithic monuments, Iron Age fortified settlements (“castros”), and Roman milestones. This long history, combined with its ecological richness, makes Corno de Bico one of the most culturally and biologically significant landscapes in northern Portugal.

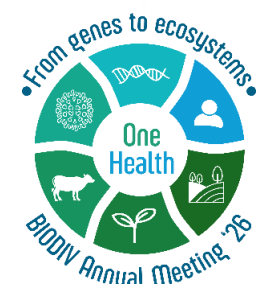
